We feel that it is important to recognise that those who worked for the retention of the protection of the right to life of the unborn in our *Constitution* did so out of a spirit of compassion for both the pregnant mother and her unborn child. True compassion is at the heart of the Christian Gospel and it continues to motivate us. It values and protects every human life from conception to natural death.”
