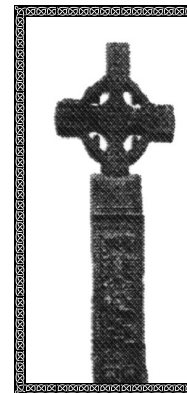

4. **Closing Mass** celebrated by Pope Francis in the Phoenix Park on Sunday 26th August.
