Celebrating on July 28th, the Vatican said the choice of date was "*meant to call attention to the fact that, sadly, loneliness is the bitter lot in life of many elderly persons, so often the victims of the throwaway culture.*"

Pope Francis celebrated the first World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly in 2021 and decreed that it be observed each year on the Sunday closest to the feast of Saints Joachim and Anne, Jesus' grandparents.

As the Catholic Church prepares for the Holy Year 2025, Pope Francis has asked Catholics to focus on prayer, which is why he chose the prayer of an elderly person from the Psalms for the theme.

So next Sunday for the 10.00am Mass in Aghadrumsee and the 11.30am Mass in Sacred Heart we invite the Grandparents and Elderly of our Parish to join us along with their families as we celebrate this special liturgy for them.
