It recalls the coming of the Gospel to Malta and St Paul's recognition of the unusual kindness received from the locals following his shipwreck.

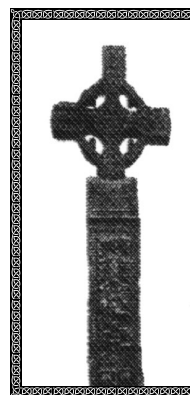
