HUGG (Healing Untold Grief Group) is a national suicide bereavement charity, providing hope and healing to adults bereaved by suicide. **HUGG Monaghan** was set up in Oct 22 to support the local community in Monaghan. The group meets every second Tuesday from 7.30pm-9.30pm and is led by trained volunteers with lived experience of suicide loss. This group provides a safe and non-judgmental space where bereaved people can share their experiences and feelings and receive and offer support to each other. HUGG Monaghan volunteer Eoin says, “*I understand that coming to terms with the loss of a loved one through suicide, whether that be a family member, friend, or colleague, is a daily struggle, and you can feel isolated and alone.
