**Fr Cornelius Tierney** was born in the townland of Golan in Aghadrumsee (Clones Parish) during 1872 and was ordained in 1899 from Maynooth. He taught in St. Macartan's College, Monaghan, until 1911 when he was appointed curate in Ballyshannon, Co Donegal, where he ministered until 1917. He joined the Society of St. Columban (then known as The Maynooth Mission To China) in 1918 and went to China during 1920. He was captured by Red Army 'bandits' during November 1930 and died in captivity on 28th February 1931. Father Tierney's remains were buried at Kien Chang, China, and a very fitting headstone was erected over his grave. Enquiries were made by Agnes McNamee (RIP), about having his remains brought home to Aghadrumsee but the city of Kien Chang had been expanded out over the graveyard and the head stone lost, leaving it impossible to locate his remains. The Columban Fathers are celebrating the centenary of the Missionary Society at St. Columban's College, Dalgan Park, Dowdstown, Navan, Co Meath. The celebrations take place on 11th November 2018, starting with a Mass at 11.00am followed by lunch and presentations about the Society. The Society wishes to locate any relatives or friends of Father Cornelius Tierney to make them aware that they would be most welcome to attend the centenary celebrations and to find out more about Fr.
