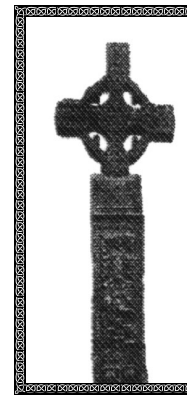
### World Meeting of Families 2018
